The race classification law, the *Population Registration Act of 1950* was **SCRAPPED in 1991** by the South African parliament. This give **job - recruitment officers**, government or private organisations, **no legal right** to classify any South African citizen by race! The SA Human Rights Commission's Hearing report of 14 March 2018 recommended to the presidency the removal of the "Coloured" categorization by **31 March 2019**. **Please do not fill in these race blocks OR** we all could tick black and confuse their statistical data.


WHO ARE WE?
